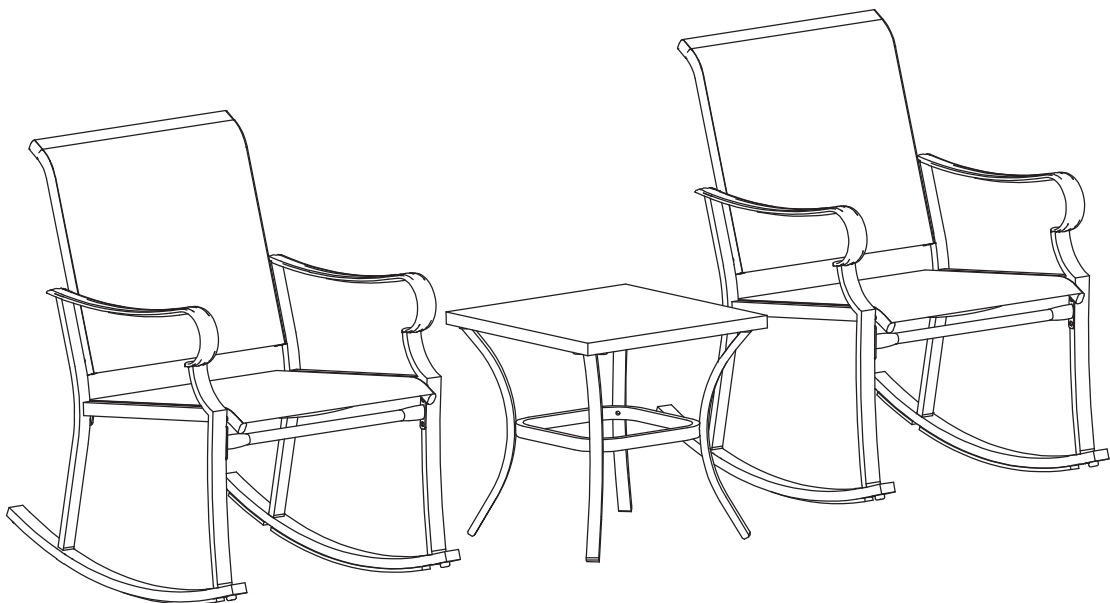

- Do not discard any of the packaging until you have checked that you have all of the required parts.




#### **Keep children away during assembly**

## PRE-ASSEMBLY

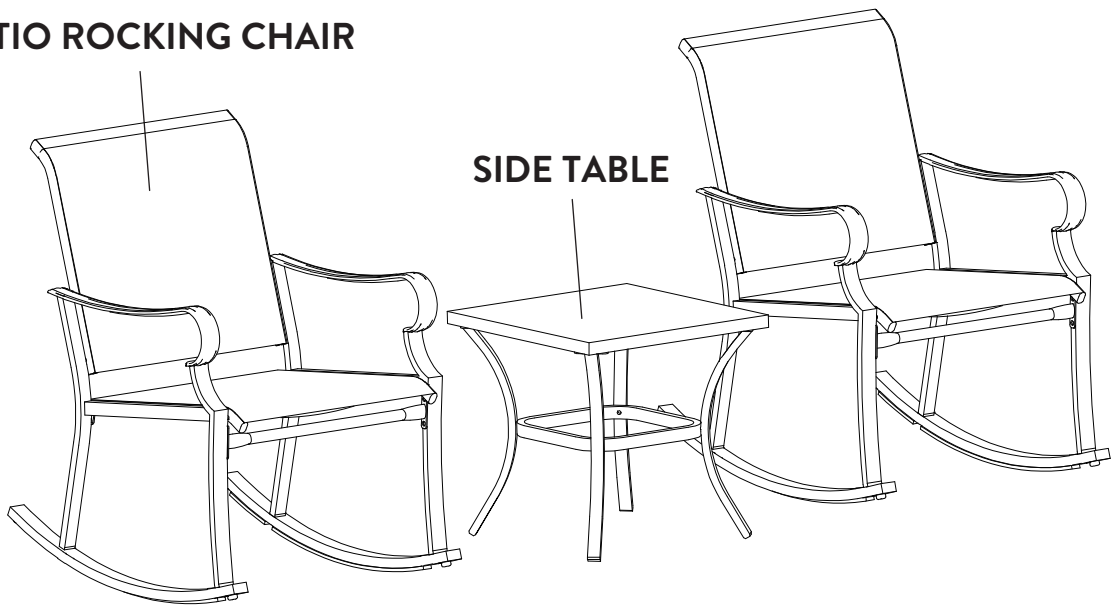
- Carefully remove all pieces from the carton and make sure that you have all parts (refer to the hardware and parts content list).

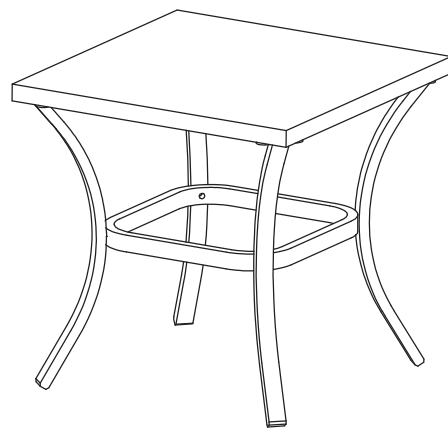

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Use a furniture cover when not in use.
- Inspect and tighten all bolts and fasteners on a regular basis to ensure the proper performance and safety of your product.
- In order to prolong the life and beauty of your furniture, we recommend that it be stored in a dry and protected area during off season periods.
- Be careful to never allow water to build up in the frames as this will cause corrosion and freeze damage in cold climates.
- Wash all frames with a solution of mild soap and water. Rinse with clean water and dry with a soft absorbent cloth towel.
- Frames can be treated with a liquid wax for maximum protection against UV rays and/or salty, damp air.
- Do not use bleach or solvents to clean any product!
